While the focus of our concern is the safety of our residents, we are also reminded of our responsibility to protect our Village financially. Our safety is first, but financial protection is vital to our Community.



Heading in the right direction

From the State of New Jersey

Effective Friday, March 19th, restaurants, recreational and amusement businesses, gyms and fitness centers, and barber shops, salons, and other personal care businesses can increase indoor capacity to 50 percent. In addition, the general outdoor gathering limit will increase to a maximum of 50 people and the general indoor gathering limit will increase to a maximum of 25 people.

These businesses must continue to abide by current health and safety protocols, including face covering and physical distancing requirements.

Indoor Gatherings

The general indoor gathering limit will increase from 10 people to 25 people.

Indoor gatherings that currently have a higher limit — religious services or ceremonies, political events, weddings, funerals, memorial services, or performances — will remain unchanged.

Outdoor Gatherings

The general outdoor gathering limit will increase from 25 people to 50 people.

Outdoor gatherings that are religious services or ceremonies, political events, weddings, funerals or memorial services will remain unchanged by the Order.



COVID 19 TESTING ONLY

On <u>April 20th</u> Ridgewood Laboratory will be coming to your community for COVID-19. Testing will take place from 10am-3pm.

All that is required is for you to bring the following items:

- Drivers license
- Insurance card(s) (primary and secondary)
- List of your medications (if any)
- List of your surgeries (if any)
- Pen (if available)

The entire testing process will be done from the comfort of your car. A team member will come up to your window and ask for your driver's license, insurance card(s), and phone number. Once your insurance is verified you will then speak to our PA (Physician's Assistant) where she will ask you about your medical history, and determine if it is medically necessary to be tested or not. When you are finished speaking with the PA you will then be tested for COVID-19.

THERE IS NO OUT OF POCKET COST AND WE ACCEPT ALL INSURANCE BUT IF YOU HAVE NO INSURANCE, PLEASE BRING YOUR SOCIAL SECURITY CARD AND WE WILL BILL THE CARES ACT.
