

Dear Mr./Ms. Unit Owner,

The renewal for insurance covering the Association's liability and property exposures was completed in March of 2021. The Whiting Village at Crestwood Community Association Board of Trustees chose to renew with Greater New York Mutual as the most competitive program. Greater New York Mutual, is A+, Superior rated by AM Best and is one of the primary carriers insuring Community Associations in New Jersey.

The contract provided by Greater New York Mutual insures the buildings according to a modified "bare walls' approach which follows language found in sections 4.i. (1)

Broadform Insurance and 6.e. Resident Responsibilities of the Association By-Laws.

Items that are not covered by the Greater New York Mutual contract include but are not limited to: All appliances-whether they are not permanently installed; lighting fixtures-including but not limited to sconces and chandeliers; plumbing fixtures-including but not limited to toilets, sinks, tubs, faucets; all cabinets-including but not limited to kitchen and bathroom; wall coverings-including paint, wallpaper and other improvements to the sheetrock surface; floor coverings-including but not limited to carpet, tile, wood, or other flooring constituting the finished surface; air-conditioning or heating equipment specific to each unit; unit owner's improvements or betterments to their space including but not limited to finished basements and remodeled kitchens; drape and other decorative window treatments.

Unit Owners are advised to purchase limits on their homeowner's policies that adequately cover these excluded items. The Unit Owner should also consider the HO-32 endorsement (expands the definition of covered perils) and HO-35 endorsement (covers certain Association assessments) to expand the scope of coverage on their HO-6 Homeowners contract. We recommend that you consult with your insurance agent to determine adequate limits for these coverages.

HO 4-55 Identity Fraud Expense Coverage

HO25-10 Personal Injury
