Voting Time: Opens 8:00am to 4:00pm

According to the By-Laws, the affairs of the Community Association shall be governed by a Board of Trustees composed of seven (7) persons who shall be Permanent Resident Members, in good standing, at least 55 years of age, and not otherwise ineligible to hold such office.

Four (4) Trustees shall be elected in an even year, and three (3) Trustees elected in an odd year. This being an odd year, there will be (3) Trustees elected to the Board and two (2) additional Trustees for positions that were appointed as Trustees since the last election. There are five (5) open positions.

Please refer to the By-Laws, page 4 Article III, Section 1.b Vacancy.

Members who will not be present on Election day may use the absentee ballot that will be provided in August, along with the list of candidates (providing there are more candidates than available openings). Members will also be provided a proxy form to use if they wish to assign someone as proxy to vote for them on the day of Election. Please note the proxy forms provided are acceptable for this day of Election only.

Those present on Election Day should have identification available in the event you are not personally recognized by committee members as a confirmed member of the Association. Example: You may use your driver's license or County ID.

Should there be an Election this year, we will host a "Meet the Candidate's Night" in Fernwood Hall on Thursday, September 9, 2021 at 6:30 pm to allow members an opportunity to hear each Candidate speak. Barring an emergency, all candidates must be present.

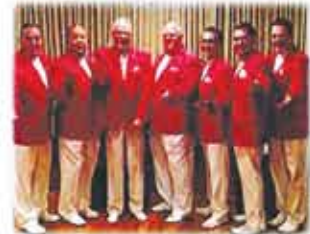

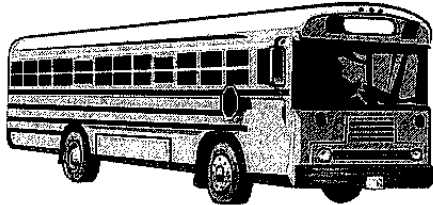
