FROM THE DESK OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

This has been a month of change and hard work. Many thanks to the homeowners who have been patient and supportive.

Our association's budget for 2022-2023 is completed. There is a \$10 increase in the monthly maintenance fee, effective JULY 2022. This amount was arrived at after many sessions with the Budget Committee, which was comprised of all Board members, and 5 voluntary homeowners, three of whom have professional financial backgrounds, and consultations with and approval by our village's accountant. It will be voted upon by the Board in front of H/Os at the MAY Sunshine Meeting. Homeowners will be able to pick up their remaining 9 monthly coupons from the Clubhouse beginning June 20, 2022. The MAY & JUNE monthly payments remain \$128.00. The July payment will be \$138.00. Thereafter the monthly amount will be \$138.00.

There was an incident of Covid in the clubhouse office late in March. The Board contacted OC Board of Health and the CDC, and followed all recommendations. Ken Freeman resigned his position as President and member of this Board of Trustees on April 11, 2022.

Joan Steever is no longer Treasurer; Carol Snider is the new Treasurer. All vendor contracts are signed, reviewed by our attorney, and in place. John's Landscaping/Snow Removal Company has now started grass cutting, the schedule will soon be available on our village website www.whitingvillage7.com.

Our new village insurance broker is Deb Fisher-Horvath, of Peter Waldor & Associates. Homeowners who wish a copy of the UNIT OWNER REQUEST form are welcome to access it from our website, or pick up the form from our clubhouse office during business hours.

Anchor Pest Control, Inc. is our new village termite inspection & treatment company. His contract began April 1, 2022.

We will be utilizing four different tree removal service companies, on an individual basis as to trees on common grounds. Homeowners with issues concerning trees on their own property should contact the clubhouse office and confer with our Vice President, Robert Buonanno or our Sgt. At Arms, Ken Stebner.

Freedom Towing & Recovery, LLC is our new towing company; they will only be addressing vehicles parked on fingers &/or finger turn-arounds. This is a safety issue, and the board asks that all residents cooperate.

The two underground oil tanks adjacent to the clubhouse are in the process of being removed by the end of May, to be replaced with above-ground tanks. We bit the bullet on this one, as both tanks were proven not to have leaks; it could have possibly cost the village over a million dollars to mediate it otherwise.
