SUNSHINE MEETING

JUNE 16 2022

All Trustees being in attendance except Barbara D'Averso and Carole Snider, Meeting opened by President Rosetta DeLuca.

Pledge of Allegiance was performed; Vice-President Robert Buonanno announced amended rules for conduct at Sunshine Meetings, to wit: Sgt.-at-Arms Ken Stebner would bring microphone to people wishing to speak. Any resident may have a maximum of 2 questions per meeting. Outbursts, angry retorts, rude and objectionable behavior will not be tolerated, and the perpetrator (s) will be warned twice. Thereafter the police will be called and the person (s) escorted from the clubhouse.

Minutes from the May 2022 Sunshine Meeting will be read at the upcoming Quarterly meeting to be held Thursday June 23. Treasurers Report for May will be also be read at that time.

Floor was opened to Questions from the audience: one resident objected to the existence of the Trustees Event Committee, holding that entity had no right to host any events whatsoever. Another resident asked the cost of the new sign at the Falmouth Ave entrance. The Board answered the cost was \$1,748.55. Other Remarks and complaints included dogs being allowed by their owners to relieve themselves on or near H/Os inground garbage cans, speeding through our village, political signs still on display over a week after the recent elections, and Manchester maintenance being careless in emptying recyclables. All concerns were answered or tabled for a future Sunshine meeting.

Meeting was moved for adjournment by President Rosetta DeLuca, seconded by Vice President Robert Buonanno. Meeting adjourned at 11:00 AM. Next Sunshine meeting is scheduled July 21, 2022 At that meeting and all Sunshine meetings thereafter, meeting will be held at 6 PM. There will no longer be any daytime Sunshine meetings.
