In 1971, Mrs. Michael Hoff, an MIA wife and member of the National League of Families, recognized the need for a symbol of our POW/MIAs. She helped design a flag to represent our missing service members. Following league approval, these flags were manufactured for distribution.

On March 9, 1989, an official league flag was installed in the U.S. Capital where it stands as a powerful symbol of national commitment to America's POW/MIAs.

On August 10, 1990, Congress recognized the flag "as the symbol of our Nation's concern and commitment to resolving as fully as possible the fates of Americans still being held as prisoners, missing and unaccounted for... their family and the Nation."

The importance of the flag lies in its continued visibility, a constant reminder of the plight of American's POW/MIAs. Other than Old Glory, the POW/MIA flag is the only flag ever to fly over the White House. The design is a silhouette of a prisoner of war (POW) before a guard tower and barbed wire in white on a black field. "POW/MIA" appears above the silhouette and the words "You Are Not Forgotten" appear in white on the black field. "MIA" stands for "missing in action. Designed by Newt Heisley



Reply to Ken Freeman and Karen Sheahan's petition and proxy

- 1. Stated interfering in election committee. Reply: The Presidents duty is to elect a chairperson. The chairperson was informed there were 2 seats to be filled. She overrode the board's decision twice, and she was removed. The President chose a member from the election committee, Helen Atkins, who Gloria, herself chose to be on the committee
- 2. Stated that placing 2022-2023 budgeting in place without meeting with owners to review same. Reply: This was done at our Sunshine meeting, and the Association's Account Skip, spoke and explained the budget to the owners, and answered questions.
- 3. Stated holding July 2022 quarterly meeting allowing no questions, meeting lasted 10 minutes Reply: There is no law stating we must open the floor to any questions, nor how long the meeting must last.
- 4. Stated holding binding votes at Sunshine meeting without a quorum of 158 homeowners. Reply: Any vote behind closed doors, must be voted on by a quorum of the BOARD in front of the owners at the next meeting.
- 5. Stated Charging the election chairperson for copies Reply: Chairperson of election, was to get approval for fliers. Chairperson is to see that every member, resident and off site owners receive this flier, and not everyone did. An approval was needed to make these copies. Therefore, she was wrong to all of the above .

We the Board carried out our fiduciary duties.
