- Sprinkle extra hot chocolate mix on top for a little extra garnish.
- To make it even more festive for the holidays, you could sprinkle in mini M&Ms or crushed candy canes to give it a different flavor.
- Store hot chocolate dip in a sealed container in the fridge for up to 4 days.

The U.S. Space Force was established Dec. 20, 2019, when the National Defense Authorization Act was signed into law (with bi-partisan support), creating the first new branch of the armed services in 73 years. The establishment of the USSF resulted from widespread recognition that Space was a national security imperative.
