

Happy New Year from the Board of Trustees * Out with the old and in with the new *

We look forward to a new year with great anticipation of more members getting involved with our Village. Give it a try, you just might have fun. The Team of Change promised you new changes and we kept our promises.... After years of requesting, underground oil tanks were removed, and thank goodness, neither one of them had leaks. We've been fighting since 2020 for the members who use the Pool Room. Finally, after 2 years we had the 2 pool tables repaired. The residents club paid the bill, as in past years. Outsiders are no longer allowed in the pool room without a V7 member who invites them, and that member must remain with their guest until games are over. The parking on the street has proved to be working and safe for V7. The rampant towing on the weekends are gone. The lawn/ snow removal company is doing what they were signed up to do and all complaints are being handled in a timely manner. Storm drains were all repaired properly and the cracks on the road were filled with new sealer to avoid future damages. Thanks to Ken Stebner and his knowledge. There is no longer a residents club board, as they could not come to any working agreement. As for Bingo, that is in limbo. The board hired a professional sprinkler repairman and saved thousands of dollars on much needed repairs. By the end of 2023, we will earn approximately \$30,000 in interest, due to the CD investments our Treasurer Howard Synder has made.

The Events committee had 2 Flea Markets, A free BBQ, thanks to a donation from Abigayle S. Panella, a Car Show, thanks to George and Chris, a Trunk or Treat, Thanksgiving Friday for residents who are homebound, a Christmas Craft show, a free coffee, cider and pie in November, a cookie swap by the generosity of our members for all residents including those who are homebound, free hot cocoa and Christmas cookies, free Manchester HS Holiday Choir and Jazz Band, thanks to Lou Tobia, hosted a fantastic and fun filled New Years Eve Gala. Thank you, Robert Buonanno for donating \$500.00 and to the committee, helping them to host some free events.

In 2023, this Board of Trustees will keep on

working for the residents to eliminate the divide and we're almost there. Check the back of our Newsletter for up and coming events.

Starting in 2023, trees and branches that need to be removed, will be done on an emergency basis only.

Trash cans will be repaired until the trash can budget runs out.

We will replace the 3 remaining entrance signs with new ones.

Please keep in mind the Board of Trustees are MEMBERS that VOLUNTEER. We are not Paw Patrol to keep an eye on the owners that have their dogs defecate and urinate on your property, or leave it all behind on your property or bag it and leave it on the street. A thought for 2023, use your cell phone, catch them in the act and bring the photos to the office.

The Board of Trustees are not the police. Our homes are fee simple, we own them, we pay our own taxes. Therefore, use your common sense! First, never, EVER, open your door to a stranger and never, ever, open your door if you are not expecting company, second, immediately CALL THE POLICE and make your report, as your well being is YOUR responsibility, not the Boards. If you see something, do something by calling the POLICE! By the time you call the office or our personal numbers and relay your message and description, you can be robbed, attacked or who knows what. This is not our responsibility! CALL THE POLICE.

FYI-Any calls that come in after hours automatically go to the phone service. In the event of an emergency, if requested, the phone service will call Stanley Contracting and have someone come out to your house to attend to the emergency. If that happens, you are responsible for the fee of \$60 that Stanley Contracting charges the village. If it can wait, call back the next business day and we will have our maintenance department come out and do their best to attend to the issue.

As for garbage disposals, after speaking with the Manchester Township Code Enforcer, we can not have garbage disposals, as we are a private development and our waste goes into pooling area which can't

accommodate the waste and will clog causing system problems.

Maintenance payments are due on the **1st** of every month. The Village allows a 15 day grace period. Residents are responsible for getting their payments in by the end of the day on the 15th. Payments received after the 15th are considered late and there will be a late charge added to the account. The Village is NOT responsible for when your bank mails out their checks or for the post office and how long it takes to get here. <u>There are 3 drop boxes at the clubhouse</u>. There is one located outside in the front parking lot. There is also one on the wall in the foyer that is open at all times and there is another located in front of the office window.


