GREETINGS FROM THE BOARD MARCH 2023

The Valentine's dance knocked it right out of the park, completely sold out! Another fantastic night for our Residents to get together. The music, dancing, food and drinks were all great! If you thought the last 2 events were excellent, coming up on March 31st is a Dinner and Dance, tickets are \$60 pp. This time besides the dancing, music, food and gifts, there will be a trip raffled off for 4 to St. Martins, including a brunch cooked by a master chef, and a sunset cruise. On May 6th there will be another Dinner and Dance, tickets are \$60 pp music, food, gifts and a trip raffled off for 4 to Tuscany, Italy.

Shuffle board is going along wonderfully. People are under the assumption that we, the Board, are trying to garner up people to join new clubs. They are way off base. The residents have come to the board and requested a bowling league, line dancing, monthly luncheons, corn hole and Atlantic City trips. The sign up lists are in the xerox room for anyone interested.

We are having a special meeting on March 4th at 10:00 am. to discuss renting the old residents club office. We will also discuss the purchasing of 3 new signs for the other 3 entrances. NOTHING else will be discussed. On the 18th of March, at the sunshine meeting, we will have a survey on the renting of the office and the 3 signs.

On our operating contingency account, the board voted on purchasing a CD for \$60,000.00 that will pay interest of 4.8%. The approximate benefit will be over \$1,700.00 for six months versus a \$3.00 per month previous investment.

Upon calls from a homeowner on Westport, regarding tent people in the back gully. Garbage was strewn all over and a pit for a campfire. After contacting the Township, Police and Fire Marshall, who could do nothing, we called on Mayor Hudak and everything was taken care of. We have now started posting No Trespassing signs around the perimeter of our village per permission from Manchester Township.

We also had a close call, thanks to a Roosevelt City resident whose property backs up to our village reported a fire. Thank God for her immediate response, or we could have lost numerous houses. The owner had a makeshift fireplace behind the house with common grounds behind it leading up to Roosevelt City property.

It is beyond belief how anyone living in this village could own or use these dangerous pits. We are surrounded by dried pine needles, leaves, and dead wood, and at a blink of an eye it can go up in flames. We would go bankrupt trying to replace your home. In accordance with our rules and regulations section 7 sub paragraph C page 5, no fire pits are allowed in Village 7. If anyone gets caught with a fire pit will be charged an "obscene" amount of money by the township and Village 7.

MAINTENANCE FEE INCREASE & COUPON PICK UP

There will be a \$10.00 increase to the maintenance fee for a total of \$148.00 a month, effective April 1st.

Residents can PICK UP their April 1, 2023-March 31, 2024 maintenance fee coupons in the lobby of Fernwood Hall on Monday, March 20th and Tuesday, March 21st between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. and between 1:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m.

National Vietnam War Veterans Day

National Vietnam War Veterans Day is a US holiday observed annually on March 29. It recognizes veterans who served in the US military during the Vietnam War. It should not be confused with Veterans Day.

History

On March 29,2012, President Barack Obama proclaimed March 29, 2012, as Vietnam Veterans Day. The proclamation called" upon all Americans to observe this day with appropriate programs, ceremonies, and activities that commemorate the 50 year anniversary of the Vietnam War."

On December 26, 2016, the Vietnam Veterans Day Coalition of States Council presented a letter to President Donald Trump and Congressional leadership outlining the history and timeline of cause to establish March 29 as Vietnam War Veterans Day and requesting that it be one of the first legislations passed and signed into law during the 115 Congress.


On March 28, 2017, President Trump signed the Vietnam War Veterans Recognition Act of 2017. This act officially recognizes March 29 as National Vietnam War Veterans Day. The Act also includes the day among those days on which the US flag should especially be displayed.

March 29 was chosen as National Vietnam War Veterans Day because on March 29, 1973, Military

Assistance Command, Vietnam (MACV) was disbanded and the last U.S. combat troops departed the Republic of Vietnam. The last unit was elements of MACV's Infantry Security Force (Special Guard), actually special couriers.
