





Scenery shots are always fun to shoot. With some guidance and practice, you may get something to hang in your home. There are a few steps you can take to enhance your scenic and landscape photos.

Use a small aperture like F11 or F22 to give your images more depth of field. If you use a camera with scene modes choose the landscape mode (the icon looks like a mountain). Since this will give you a longer exposure I recommend using a tripod to steady your camera.

I always use a polarizing filter with landscape images. It will cut glare and





make the colors and clouds pop (just like your sunglasses). I like to shoot with a wide angle lens to take in more of the scene. If you can, include a foreground object to give your images more scale and perspective.
