Important Information Regarding Water and Sewer Pipes and Insurance

Please be advised that the water and sewer pipes in Village 7 are approximately 50 years old. Recently, there were a few occasions where a pipe burst and the repair was very costly for the homeowner.

If you live on a finger, it is the homeowners responsibility for the pipes from the house to the finger street. If you live on the main road, it is the homeowners responsibility for the pipes from the house to the swales.

The Board of Trustees investigated the following companies and found that insurance on the pipes is very affordable and feel it is in the best interest of the homeowners to purchase the insurance for them. Feel free to use any insurance company you choose. Either way, we highly recommend that you get insurance on the pipes under your home.

Please join us for the Village 7's Annual Tree Lighting ceremony outside our clubhouse on December 5th at 6:00 p.m. We will have a sing-along before entering to enjoy desserts, coffee, tea and hot cocoa.

Bakers get ready for baking cookies for our homebound residents. Join us in the kitchen on December 12th at 1:00 p.m. to package and deliver.

Be aware: If you are going to rent a dumpster, please be sure to ask for insurance from the dumpster company in case they damage your driveway. If possible, ask them to sit the dumpster on wood planks or something equivalent. We have had two incidents where there were water leaks from the dumpsters.



Effective October 1, 2025


Starting October 1st, on odd numbered calendar days, residents will park their cars on the “odd number address” side of the street. For example; on October 3rd, you will park on the side of 125 Front Street. On even numbered days, residents will park cars on the “even number address” side of the street. For example; on October 6th, you will park on the side of 128 Front Street. You can look at the mailboxes for the street numbers.

*This will apply for
October, November and December.*

Remember not to block mailboxes.

to park with the flow of traffic.**




